


# THE 2024 GENERAL ELECTION FACTBOOK







# Introduction

This book began life as a souped-up guide to the incoming parliamentary constituencies, based around the Rallings and Thrasher notional results. All was on track to be ready well before the expected November 2024 general election. Then Rishi Sunak called a July election.

Two options presented themselves. Either the - largely completed - project could be thrown in the recycle bin. Or it could be turned into a reference for the election itself, featuring the actual results rather than the notionals. You can deduce which idea carried the day.

This was always intended to be a little more than a record of one general election but a handy guide to the characteristics and history of each constituency. So let me explain what we have here.

Following this introduction are maps of the countries and regions of the United Kingdom - to easily understand where each constituency fits in relation to others.

Thereafter, each of the 650 constituencies gets its own page comprising a ward map, the full 2024 general election result, a list of MPs who have had the privilege of representing it, a cluster of demographic indicators, the constituency's electoral history going back, wherever possible, to 1945, and how the most close antecedent voted in the 2016 EU referendum.

The first two bits of information: the 2024 result and the list of MPs - hopefully need no explanation. The rest does.

The demographic data is from the 2021 Census, helpfully compiled by Bjorn Hattan, who can be found on the Vote UK discussion forum. Unfortunately there is no census data for Scotland because their parliament pushed back its publication by a year and so was unpublished as I completed this book.

This data looks at five measures that define each constituency: housing tenure, ethnicity, social class, education and age. In Northern Ireland, slightly different data sets have been published so social class is replaced by religion - still a major driver of voting intention in the province.

Housing is analysed in terms of owned property (that is: both owned outright and with a mortgage); publicly rented (council or housing association, but not what has become known as "intermediate"); and privately rented.

Ethnicity is, somewhat crudely broken down into white (including non-British white), black (principally those with an African or Caribbean origin), and Asian (which overwhelmingly means of the Indian subcontinent - there are very few south east Asians in the UK). This does not discern between Muslims and Hindus, or indeed Asians of neither religion.

Social class - a fading concept in sociological terms but interesting still politically - comprises ABs: managers and senior executives, entrepreneurs - generally the most affluent in society. C1s and C2s are white collar workers at any position in employment bar the top. Ds are essentially blue collar workers ranging from eg mechanics to street sweepers, plumbers and electricians. Es are entirely unskilled workers.

The educational categories are clear: those with higher qualifications against those without and the proportion of students resident in that constituency.

Likewise the age category contrasts over-64s with under-35s.

Then there is the constituency's electoral history. In the overwhelming majority of cases, a constituency has a fairly apparent lineage, even where its name has been changed (Ebbw Vale to Blaenau, Gwent for example; or the new North West Essex seat being the clear successor to Saffron Walden).

Sometimes rapidly growing areas spawn constituencies. Milton Keynes, until it was designated a New Town, was part of the massive Buckingham constituency. Today it boasts two whole constituencies to itself and is well on its way to a third.

And then there are seats comprising areas that have been forced together. Take Chelsea and Fulham. Fulham is the much larger contributor but has a Labour

history that would confuse rather than illuminate. Equally, Chelsea was far more Conservative than the amalgamated seat. So here I have chosen to only take the electoral history back to 2010, when the seat was created.

The final data set is the estimate of how each constituency voted in the 2016 EU referendum. These were estimated by Chris Hanretty for the constituencies in place at the time so are not entirely accurate for the new ones. That said, they are broadly still meaningful in their own right. But more importantly, how someone voted in that referendum points to a range of political values that extend beyond how content with the European Union that voter was.

A Leave voter is more likely to be socially conservative than a Remainer, to be rooted in the community in which they grew up; to favour national sovereignty over internationalist political structures; to oppose mass immigration and so on.


I come at electoral politics not as an academic but from hands-on, front-line experience as a former councillor and election agent. I am more interested in explaining and presenting electoral data than I am in the zealous ring-fencing of precise facts and figures. In other words, I may take more liberties in connecting constituencies that, over time may have altered quite radically, than an academic would be happy doing. I don't show which constituencies I have used as antecedents, though this can be worked out from the list of MPs I have provided.
